

# SCOTT CITY COUNCIL MEETING

May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022

**Call to order:** A meeting of the Council was held on May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022, in the Council Chambers located at City Hall, 215 Chester Ave. Mayor Norman Brant called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. The following council members were present: Randy Morse, Rick Brashear, Jack Howard, Kenny Page, Heather Ingvalson, Victor Phillips and Mike Rhymer.

**Prayer and Pledge:** Prayer was led by Pastor Larry Rouse. Pledge was led by Mayor Norman Brant.

**Approval of Agenda:** Motion to approve May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022, made by Councilwoman Heather Ingvalson; Seconded by Councilman Mike Rhymer. All in favor; None opposed; Motion carried.

**Approval of Minutes:** Motion to approve May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022, meeting minutes made by Councilman Jack Howard; Seconded by Councilman Victor Phillips. 5 in favor; 2 abstained (Randy Morse and Heather Ingvalson); Motion carried.

**Approval of Bills:** Motion to approve bills in the amount of \$28,618.90 was made by Councilman Kenny Page; Seconded by Councilwoman Heather Ingvalson. All in favor; None opposed; Motion carried.

## Public Forum:

- Mike Braun – Concerned about dust issue coming from Missouri Tie and Timber. Interim Public Works Director, Cletus Glueck and Code Enforcement Officer, Dustin Johnson went to speak with the person over Missouri Tie and Timber to address the issue. If the dust problem doesn't get fixed they will start receiving tickets for the issue.

## City Administrator, Dustin Whitworth:

- Herman Schultz has been working on 706 3<sup>rd</sup> St and updating on the progress.
- Needed funds to finish the City's list of street paving is up to \$100,000. Motion to approve up to \$100,000 for street paving made by Councilman Victor Phillips; Seconded by Councilman Kenny Page. All in favor. None opposed. Motion carried.
- In need of a new City Admin vehicle. Quotes for a new 2022 Ford Explorer comes to \$40,000. This would be plan B. The 2 new Explorers for Police that the City acquired through a grant may be able to be used for a City Admin vehicle. Waiting on a call from Jason Hartke to see if one

can be used for that purpose. Right now the Explorers are not being used. The City paid over \$50,000 for their portion aside of the grant for these 2 new Explorers. The best scenario would be to keep one for the City Admin vehicle. Motion to approve purchase of a new 2022 Explorer for City Admin vehicle (half out of this fiscal budget and half out of next fiscal budget) if one of the new PD Explorers cannot be used for City Admin, made by Councilwoman Heather Ingvalson; Seconded by Councilman Randy Morse. All in favor. None opposed. Motion carried.

**Victor Phillips, Admin/Finance:**

- Met with City Administrator, Dustin Whitworth and Admin/Finance Committee to discuss next years budget proposal. Meeting went well and Dustin has a great understanding of the budget.

**Police Chief, Rick Walter:**

- Will be getting quotes for striping of the regular patrol cars. Once quotes come in will review the budget to see where funds need to come out of.
- Met with City Administrator, Dustin Whitworth and Mike Umfleet, School Superintendent about the SRO salary and contract with Scott City School. The School board meeting coming up will discuss the topic and Mike Umfleet will get back with us with more information.

Motion to emergency hire Tina Kolwyck as dispatcher at \$18.00 per hour made by Councilman Randy Morse; Seconded by Councilman Kenny Page. All in favor. None opposed. Motion carried.
